**Subject:** Follow-up: Noise Monitoring System Issues (Pond Street NMT still offline)

Good afternoon,

I am writing to follow up on my previous email regarding several issues affecting the reliability and transparency of GTAA's public noise-monitoring and flight-tracking systems.

To date, I have not received a response.

In particular, the **Pond Street Noise Monitoring Terminal still appears to be offline** and has now been unavailable for several weeks. I have not seen any public notice indicating that the monitor is out of service or under maintenance.

Because surrounding communities rely on these systems to understand real-world noise exposure, prolonged outages without disclosure raise concerns regarding monitoring reliability and transparency.

For clarity, I would appreciate confirmation of the following:

1. The **cause of the Pond Street NMT outage**
2. The **date the monitor went offline**
3. The **expected timeline for restoration**
4. Whether any **public notice of the outage** has been issued or is planned

I would also welcome responses to the questions raised in my original message regarding WebTrak availability and other monitoring anomalies.

As part of ongoing documentation of monitoring reliability, I am keeping records of these outages and associated correspondence. For ease of reference, I have attached the original message and a current screenshot showing the Pond Street monitor still offline.

I would appreciate any update you are able to provide.
